# **Alliance Research at ESMO Congress 2025**

The Alliance for Clinical Trials in Oncology and Alliance Foundation Trials, LLC (AFT) presented key findings from four major studies at the European Society for Medical Oncology (ESMO) Congress 2025, which took place October 17-21 in Berlin, Germany. These presentations highlighted advancements across prostate, breast, colorectal, and neuroendocrine cancers and demonstrate the Alliance's continued leadership in practice-defining clinical research.

## **Top Journals Feature Alliance Research**

From September 1, 2024, through August 31, 2025, Alliance investigators published 51 manuscripts. Of these, 31 papers (66%) appeared in journals with an Impact Factor greater than 5. Notably, six papers were published in high-impact journals with an Impact Factor over 40: two in the *New England Journal of Medicine* (IF 78.5), one in *JAMA* (IF 55), one in *Nature Medicine* (IF 49.2), and two in the *Journal of Clinical Oncology* (IF 43.4).
