NCTN Swim Lane Rule


 Adult Group sites must function under a LAPS grant, a CCOP grant, or under the NCTN Group grants (Rostered) and can only participate under one of these mechanisms (swim lane rules).





Participation Rules for LAPS


- Tier 1 sites are administrative and cannot accrue subjects.
- Tier 2 and Tier 3 sites are enrolling sites and are eligible for audit.
- LAPS may be on multiple Group rosters and Groups must claim all sites within the LAPS grant.
- Enrollments for LAPS sites will be paid for by the LAPS grant.
- Enrollments for the LAPS aligned affiliates and LAPS aligned sub affiliates will be paid by the credited Network Group(s).







Participation Rules for CCOPS/MB-CCOPS




- Tier 1 sites are administrative and cannot accrue subjects but may be eligible for audit.
- Tier 2 and Tier 3 sites are enrolling sites and are eligible for audit.
- CCOPs may be on multiple Group rosters and Groups must claim all sites within the CCOPs grant.
- CCOP enrollments will be paid for by the CCOP grant.



Participation Rules for Adult Network Groups

- Tier 1 Main Members, all Tier 2 Affiliates and Tier 3 Sub affiliate sites are enrolling sites.
- All enrolling sites will be eligible for audit.
- Sites can be on multiple NCTN rosters.
- Main Member/Affiliate sites can participate in multiple tiers across groups, but can only be claimed once by a group (e.g. Main Member for Group A, but Affiliate for Group B).






Crediting Rules

- US sites may credit any participating Network Group to which the site and credited investigator are affiliated and participating on the protocol.
- Canadian sites must credit the NCTN Group that holds the CTA.
- International sites must credit the Lead Protocol Organization (LPO) if they are a member of the LPO.
- International sites that are not members of the LPO must receive approval from their credited group and consistently credit the same group for the protocol.



INDIVIDUAL PARTICIPATION

The Alliance membership structure is composed of institutional membership with investigators and non-investigators on the member institution's roster. All persons being added to the Alliance roster must have an NCI ID (investigators) or a CTEP ID (non-investigators). 
Adding or deleting persons from the Alliance roster for non-CCOP members

Investigators and staff: To add or delete a person from the Alliance roster the Lead CRP should sign and submit a completed roster update form to roster@AllianceNCTN.org. For all new persons, please also submit a copy of their Human Subject Protection Training Certificate.

Principal Investigators: To change an institution's Principal Investigator (PI) a letter of notification of the change signed by both the outgoing and incoming PI must be addressed to the Group Chair and submitted to the Membership Manager at membership@AllianceNCTN.org. Please include within the letter the effective date and if the outgoing PI will continue membership as an investigator or will need to be withdrawn. In addition to the letter of notification, submit a roster form, Alliance COI Form, CV or NIH Biosketch, and a copy of the Human Subject Protection Training Certificate for the incoming PI.

Co-Principal Investigators, Lead Clinical Research Professional (CRP), and Secondary Lead Clinical Research Professionals: To change Co-Pls, Lead CRP, and Secondary Lead CRPs submit a roster form to membership@AllianceNCTN.org.








Workflow for LAPS/Non-CCOP Sites (Post Transition)

From Mar to July 2014




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Workflow for LAPS/Non-CCOP Sites (Post Transition)

Payments



Federal payment categories

- Funding for trial activities will fall under one of the following categories:
 - Screening for Intervention
 - Basic Intervention
 - Advanced Imaging
 - Biospecimen Collection
 - Special (complex or rare disease trials)
 - Quality of Life
 - Non-NCI/DCTD Funding (e.g., Industry)



Federal payment types

- Funding pages updated on CTSU website for each NCTN protocol
- Funding levels are approved by CTEP prior to protocol activation

OPEN and payment triggers

- For 'mandatory' funding types such as 'basic intervention' or 'screening,' completion of the patient enrollment in OPEN is considered the triggering event for payment eligibility
- For imaging and biospecimen payments, site staff are required to enter data via OPEN at the time the site becomes eligible for payment
- Funding screen will only be visible when there is optional or conditional funding for a study




Optional and conditional funding

- Optional Funding Type A test or evaluation that is offered to the patient but is not required for the patient to participate on the study
- Conditional Funding Type A test or evaluation that <u>is required</u> per the protocol for patient participation on a study but is dependent upon other parameters, such as patient eligibility



OPEN Funding Screen



Funding Type, Funding Type # and Specify will be pre-filled based on funding available for the study.



Foundation payments

- Available to all sites and dispersed from Group credited
 - Phase II complexity for concepts approved by CTEP prior to 8/31/2012
 - Supplemental funds for NCI trials
 - Pass through payments from other Groups




