Tip Sheet #2 How to Accrue to CANVAS

Tips for Finding Eligible Patients

- ✓ Partner with a hematologist at your site and include as sub-investigator on study
- ✓ Present study to medical oncologists in all disease groups to increase study awareness
- ✓ Post CANVAS flyers in workrooms and clinician areas reminding them to be on the lookout for cancer patients who get blood clots
- ✓ Run weekly reports that query your site's electronic medical record for new blood clot diagnoses (in patients with cancer) using ICD codes
- ✓ Send recurring emails (weekly or monthly) to all study staff/investigators at your site to keep this study on everyone's radar and keep momentum going

How to Register a CANVAS Participant

- ✓ Obtain a signed informed consent form from the participant and administer the Baseline Study Questionnaire
- Register the participant by submitting the Eligibility Checklist/Enrollment Form at https://redcap.partners.org/redcap/
- ✓ Send patient home with 6-months' worth of Medication Diaries
