Status of Manuscript

- Submitted to Journal of Clinical Oncology 3/30/2016
 - Decision: Reject
- Submitted to Cancer early May 2016



Next Steps

- Publish manuscript
- Push for cancer clinical trials to incorporate the NCI-AACR Cancer Patient Tobacco Use Assessment Task Force's recommended "Core" and "Extension" assessment items at initial and follow-up time points
- Use lessons learned from this project in future pooled analyses of the association between smoking, patient characteristics, and clinical outcomes in lung cancer clinical trials
